



## What is Partial Disbursement?

AWS Marketplace has now made faster payments possible through Partial Disbursements - Now Live for invoices transacted via the AWS Inc., EMEA, Australia, and Japan AWS Marketplace Operators (MPOs). The Partial Disbursement feature enables AWS Marketplace to release funds to sellers upon receipt of partial invoice payments from buyers. Disbursements are calculated proportionally based on the payment amount received against the total invoice value.

## Benefits

Prior to release of the Partial Disbursement feature, sellers would have to wait for invoices to be collected in full by AWS Marketplace. The partial disbursement feature allows sellers faster access to funds as they do not have to wait for the buyer to pay the invoice in full. With this feature, sellers will now receive funds for partially collected invoices based on the associated disbursement schedule.

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- 1. I'm an existing seller on AWS MP, do I need to take any action to leverage the Partial Disbursement feature?**
  - Sellers (independent software vendors (ISVs) and channel partners (CPs), who have a partially paid invoice transacted via the AWS Inc., EMEA, AU and JP MPO will be able to receive partial disbursements to their bank account based on the disbursement preference cadence set by the seller in the AWS MP Management Portal (AMMP).
- 2. Will Partial Disbursement feature apply to previous partially paid invoices (partially paid before the feature launch)?**
  - Partial Disbursement feature will be applicable to invoices which were partially paid prior to the launch of the Partial Disbursement feature. For any previously partially paid invoice transacted via the AWS Inc., EMEA, AU, and JP MPO, disbursements will occur proportional to the paid invoice amount.
- 3. Will there be any changes in the AWS MP Seller Reporting with the launch of Partial Disbursement feature?**
  - Yes, there will be changes to the AWS MP Seller Reporting with the launch of Partial Disbursement feature. The Billed Revenue dashboard will continue to show all invoices generated regardless of disbursement status.

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- The Collections and Disbursement dashboard will not include invoices where a disbursement has not transpired. To review invoices not disbursed use the Billed revenue dashboard. ### 4. What are the key changes to the Billed Revenue Dashboard?

- Addition of two new columns: 'Disbursed Net Revenue' and 'Undisbursed Net Revenue'
- New metric 'Undisbursed Net Revenue' added to Key Metrics
- Disburse bank trace ID column may now surface multiple IDs in the event there have been multiple partial disbursements on an invoice

### 5. What are the key changes to the Collections and Disbursement Dashboard?

- Addition of two new columns: 'Disbursed Net Revenue' and 'Undisbursed Net Revenue'
- Addition of two new picklist options to 'Disbursement Status' filter: 'Partially Disbursed' and 'Failed' statuses.
- There will be multiple disbursement events (with unique IDs in the disburse bank trace ID column) in the case of multiple partial disbursements on an invoice.
